

Format of the Abstract

The abstract should be formatted following the example on the next page. The page size is set in A4 with standard margin of 3.8 cm (1.5 inch) on left side and 2.54 cm (1 inch) on other sides. The text in the abstract should be set to justify. The first word of the title and all major words must start with capital letter. After a blank line write the authors. Title and authors must be set centred. After a blank line write the affiliation and email following the format below. After a blank line write the heading **Abstract** in Times New Roman 12 pt bold. The body of the abstract of no more than 500 words should be in Times New Roman 12 pt. After a blank line write the heading **Keywords** in Times New Roman 12 pt bold. The keywords should be in Times 12 point italic, separated with commas.

Abstract Guidance:

1. Introduction and Objectives
Introductory statement of the importance, reasons and objectives for investigating the topic/project
2. Method Used
Summarisation of key points and overview on how this investigation was conducted
3. Observation/Data/Results and Discussion
Should provide a key results that lead directly to the conclusions you have drawn
4. Conclusion
Summary sentences that should reflect on the process and results obtained in the study/work/project

Title of Article Should Concisely and Accurately Specify Subject of Paper (Times New Roman – 14 pt, bold)

This example is to demonstrate the layout of the first page of a "camera-ready" article for International Conference on Connect-Us Conference (CuC) 2019. The title, authors' names and addresses should be set as centre of the text area. The abstract itself, set in 12 pt of Times New Roman font type like the authors' addresses, should start about x cm down from the top of the text area. Please do not make reference citations in the abstract and please keep within the limit of 500 words.

Abstract, author details, example, headings, layout, title page (Times New Roman – 12 pt, italic)
